Sapporo is celebrated for its vibrant urban environment surrounded by fabulous natural landscapes, offering a great balance of arts, traditional culture, food and nightlife opportunities. Meanwhile Niseko's beautiful backdrop and rapid development make it one of the fastest growing tourism areas in Japan. Enjoy the beautiful spring/summer panorama whilst experiencing what makes these two regions truly compelling urban destinations.

The study tour will offer members a unique opportunity to network with the wider ULI community and engage in a meaningful exchange of knowledge and experiences with other industry professionals.

Thursday <b>30 May</b>	Meet at Haneda International Airport for your flight to New Chitose Airport  Take part in the Summit's morning Sunrise Wellness programme, join a Tokyo study tour, and then depart for Sapporo with your peers.  Visit to Cocono Susukino followed by dinner  Visit Susukino, a bustling entertainment neighbourhood renowned as the largest entertainment zone in the north of Japan, and take a private guided tour of a vibrant mixed use complex boasting dining, shopping and entertainment in the heart of the district.  Cocono Susukino, Sapporo's latest large-scale development, overlooks the lively Susukino intersection and iconic Nikka Whisky neon sign.  The group will end the night at Sapporo Beer Garden, where we dine on 'Genghis Khan' and sip on freshly brewed beer delivered directly from the factory.  Overnight stay in Sapporo (two nights)  Sapporo Stream Hotel. The newly opened hotel is located in the heart of Susukino Crossing, allowing tour participants easy access to the entertainment district into the night.
Friday <b>31 May</b>	Visit to Hotel Sosei Sapporo MGallery followed by lunch  MGallery inaugurates a new historical location in Sapporo, entirely revamped to uphold and perpetuate the local heritage. Established in a private residence from the pioneer district, Hotel Sosei Sapporo MGallery pays tribute to Japanese traditions, right from the entrance.  Proceed to lunch at Hokkaido's premier traditional restaurant, adored by notable figures from all walks of life for more than 70 years.  Hokkaido Ballpark F Village and Es Con Field Hokkaido  Hokkaido Ballpark F Village represents a new way of enjoying sports. Built on an 80-acre site, the development features a variety of activities in harmony with nature, including barbeque facilities, glamping and cycling along the Village's waterfront and lawns.  Nestled within the Village lies Es Con Field Hokkaido, Japan's first natural grass ballpark with a retractable roof. After a guided tour, we end our evening by enjoying an exciting Nippon-Ham Fighters game from the coveted Balcony Suite, a premium space that includes an elegant lounge space and terrace overlooking the entire field.
Saturday <b>1 June</b>	Luxury hospitality in Niseko  Niseko's luxury hospitality sector has embraced the unique cultural and natural elements of the region, offering a blend of traditional Japanese hospitality and modern luxury amenities against a stunning backdrop of the nearby Annupuri mountain range and Mount Yotei.  The group will have an opportunity to participate in private stakeholder-led tours at Club Med Kiroro Grand and Club Med Kiroro Peak, both closed to outsiders in the off-season. Our host will share how La Tribute and Sheraton were transformed with limited budgets and tight schedules into Club Med properties with distinct positionings.  Our tour will lead the group to Park Hyatt Niseko Hanazono, where our host will share the learning behind the challenges and successes of a resort of this scale. We will also visit exclusive houses at the Annupuri Residences, a multi-million dollar villa development with 4-5 en suite bedrooms and generous amenities.  Enjoy drinks and a presentation on the Niseko region before proceeding to dinner.  Overnight stay in Niseko  Setsu Niseko. A resort for all seasons flanked by two spectacular mountains in one of the finest locations within Grand Hirafu.
Sunday <b>2 June</b>	Check out and transfer by luxury bus from Niseko to New Chitose Airport, connecting to international flights.  Or extend your stay at your own cost. All return flights must be self-arranged.
